MINUTES OF MARCH 28, 2024
SANITARY DISTRICT COMMISSION MEETING

The March 2024 meeting of the Bohner's Lake Sanitary District Commission was held on Thursday, March 28, 2024 at 5:00 PM at the Burlington Hall located at 32288 Bushnell Rd., Burlington, WI 53105. Present at the meeting were Commissioners Harvey Kandler, Carrie Oldenburg, and Jess Wiskes; Attorney Rich Scholze; Mark Kolczaski of Baxter & Woodman; District Admin/Accountant Ruth DeLay; and District Secretary Denise Rintz.

1. Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Public Comments:

- a. **Angelyn Tucker** – 7955 Ridgeway Drive – Insurance claims: She would like to see a more comprehensive process for filing claims when there are issues with the system. She was not even aware of there was a process in place when her home was damaged from sewage.
- b. **AJ Tucker** – 7955 Ridgeway Drive – His house was flooded and stated that there is not a point of contact for this. He is looking for an apology from the district. He had his house checked from the system by True Masters before he bought the house. Maintenance is cheaper than repair. He would like a formal apology after the meeting.
- c. **John Tithof** – 33608 S Lakeshore Dr. – John commented on Harvey Kandler's letter that was mailed to all constituents. The two items he wanted to point out was the meaning of two words: Listening – to pay attention to sound; to hear something with thoughtful attention; give consideration. Honesty – free from fraud or deception. He stated that his letter was unbelievable.

3. Approval of Meeting Minutes from the February 22, 2024 Meeting: Kandler/Wiskes made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the February 22, 2024. Motion passed unanimously.

4. Baxter & Woodman: There has been some interest on new connection from home builders Wausau Home and Belinski Homes. Green Bay Pipe and TV is scheduled to begin annual televising of the system in the July-August timeframe.

5. Lift Stations/Sanitary System: There was some vandalism on lift station 3. It was reported to the police. We will prosecute if the police find the perpetrator. New pumps for lift station 10 are being built and should be delivered in the near future.

7. Mitigation Field: Removed the beaver dams and the trees that have fallen over.

9. Invoices for Approval: Motion was made by Kandler/Wiskes to accept the invoices for payment. Motion passed unanimously.
