MINUTES OF THE APRIL 23, 2026
SANITARY DISTRICT COMMISSION MEETING

The April 2026 meeting of the Bohners Lake Sanitary District Commission was held on Thursday, April 23, 2026 at 5:00 PM at the Burlington Town Hall located at 32288 Bushnell Rd., Burlington, WI 53105. Present at the meeting were Commissioners Phil Paustian, Brenda Szumski, and John Titof; and District Secretary Denise Rintz Brehm, and District Admin/Accountant Ruth DeLay.

1. **Welcome – Call to Order**
2. **Pledge of Allegiance**
3. **Public Comment** – No public comments.
4. **Welcome Commissioner John Titof** – Welcome to John Titof as our newest elected commissioner. John is replacing Amber Della Bianca who chose to step down at the end of her term. We appreciate all of Amber's outstanding selfless service these past two years.
5. **Approval of March 26, 2026 Meeting Minutes**
 - Motion was made by Paustian with a second by Szumski to approve the March 26, 2026 meeting minutes as written. Motion passed unanimously.
6. **Sanitary Stations/Sanitary System**
 - Sanitary system updates – no significant performance issues across the system this past month. Even with the amount of rain we had, our flow only rose slightly to 199,000 gallons versus last year. About \$600 more than last year.
7. **Lake Preservation**
 - Big Foot Archers Club – Carp Reduction Event – Saturday April 25. We are uncertain if we'll proceed due to timing of the carp spawn.
 - Summer harvesting scheduled
 - Wisconsin Lake and Ponds confirmed the treatment of our lake on April 28.
 - Wisconsin DNR has been notified and approved this date.
 - Notifications mailed or hand delivered to homes near the treatment areas.
 - Harvesting and weed pick-up dates
 - June 2-8 – Brown's Lake team will harvest
 - June 8-12 – Clearwater team will harvest
 - ASDA on street pick up for June 18
8. **Wetlands Updates**
 - Wetlands maintenance season under way – volunteer opportunities available. If interested, see Brenda or Phil.
9. **8081 Lakeshore Drive Property** – nothing new to report
10. **ASDA – Added weed pick up date** – Homeowners along Park St asked about adding another pickup date for weeds and leaves that blew over to the East side of the lake. The cost to add a pick-up date would be \$875 by ASDA plus fuel surcharge. Motion was made by Paustian with a second by Szumski. Motion passed unanimously for an additional pick up date for the third week of May.
11. **Invoices for Approval** – motion was made to approve invoices presented by Paustian with a second by Szumski. Motion carried unanimously.
